Primary 3, 4 & 5



Admission Process

The academic session begins in April of each year and continues till March of the following year. While admissions are ongoing throughout the year, most seats are taken by March for the following session.

Students are admitted from 2.5 years of age.

Our entry ages are:

Playway : 2.5 to 3 years

Nursery:3+

Lower KG: 4 to 5 years

Upper KG: 5 to 6 years

Primary Grade 1 : 6 to 7 years

Primary Grade 2:7 to 8 years

Primary Grade 3:8 to 9 years

Primary Grade 4: 9 to 10 years

Primary Grade 5: 10 + years

We always tryto ensure that children are placed in a ageappropriate group, though there is always some flexibility in placement depending on a child's level of development, maturity and academic abilities. Children in Primary 1 to 5 are unlikely to be 'accelerated' due to the importance of establishing a firm educational foundation for the future. This would only normally happen in very exceptional circumstances and only in the interests of the child.

During the Admission on process, Parents may visit the school for a tour along with their children. They can also interact with the Academic staff during the scheduled visit.

Upon registration and registration fee payment, your child will be invited to undertake placement test and an interview (this normally takes approximately 3 hours). Placement test are for students aiming to enter Primary 1 and above.

Preliminary Instructions for new Entrants :

- The child should start coming to the school on the first coming Monday after his / her admission.
- The 'Admission Slip' should be presented in the office on the first day of joining.
- For gradual transition, for the first week, the child will attend the school from 10 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. The parents are required to drop and pick up the child themselves.
- The child should carry a small bag (write the child's name on it) with napkin, handkerchief and a spare dress in it.
- The child should be sent to the school in proper school uniform from the day of his / her joining the school.
- The child's almanac should he returned everyday after reading & signing at the bottom of the page.
- 7. If you wish to avail the school transport service, meet the concerned driver to know/explain the details regarding timing, address etc. Get your child's name entered in the 'Transport List' in the office. From the day the child's name is included in the list, the child will be sent home by the school transport.

Withdrawal

- 1. The school has a right to ask the students to leave the school on the following grounds :
 - a. Gross Misconduct in the discipline.
 - b. Unsatisfactory academic progress in work.
 - c. Repeated detentions in the class.
 - d. Cheating in Periodicals/Terminal exams.
- 2. The students who want to get admission to any other school due to any reason should fill their 'No Dues' form with an application and submit the same to the Headmistress.
- 3. SLC will be issued one week later after the clearance of the dues, If any.
